

PBIS Behavior Lesson Plan – HALLWAY COOL TOOL

UNIVERSAL EXPECTATIONS: Be Respectful, Be Responsible

NAME OF SKILL/SETTING: Hallway Behavior

SEL STANDARD: Goal 3 – Demonstrate decision-making skills and responsible behaviors in personal, school, and community contexts.

PURPOSE OF THE LESSON/WHY IS IT IMPORTANT

1. To maintain a hallway environment that is safe, quiet, and orderly.
2. To get from one place to another in a safe, quick, and quiet manner.
3. To maintain patience in congested areas.

TEACHING EXAMPLES/POINTS TO MAKE TO STUDENTS

1. Always walk on the right side of the hallway and stairs. “Stay to the right!” **Be Respectful**
2. “Walk and Talk” so you are not late or causing congestion in the hallway. **Be Responsible**
3. When you see your friend(s) in the hallway, speak softly to acknowledge them. You should also wave to them. **Be Respectful**
4. If you are near the stairwell and the area is congested, patiently wait to use the right side of the stairs. **Be Respectful**
5. If you are using the stairs behind others who are slower, proceed patiently and do not pass them. **Be Respectful**
6. Notice the Enter (green) signs above certain doors and Do Not Enter (red) signs above doors. Enter on the right side, exit on the right side. Use the color codes to help. **Be Responsible**
7. As you walk to class, keep your books, drawstring bag, hands, and feet to yourself since you want to demonstrate how to **be respectful and responsible**

STUDENT ACTIVITIES/ROLE PLAYS

1. Role play **incorrect** behaviors by having students stand around and talk, not walk on the right side of the hallway, not use the right side of the stairs, pass others on the stairs using the left side, etc.
2. Have students walk in the hallway communicating softly with their peers and acknowledging their friends by waving. **CORRECT**
3. Have students use the stairs by staying to the right, not passing others, and using the right side doorway to enter hallways from the stairs. **CORRECT**

FOLLOW UP/REINFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES

1. Tape divider on stairs if needed
2. No passing zone signs and door signs – Enter = Green – Do Not Enter = Red
3. Reinforce positive behaviors with Charger Checks
